- October 1 <u>First Wings Award</u> application deadline (awarded by The 99s International organization for primary training)

Attention Student Pilots!

The spring First Wings Award deadline is 1 April. If you are a student pilot who has been a member of The 99s since on or before 1 January 2025, and have logged at least five hours of flight training in the six months prior to the application deadline of April 1, you may qualify for an award of up to \$6000. An updated version of the application will be available on the international website on or about 1 February. If you are preparing to apply here are some tips:

- Download the application before filling any fields the online form does not save any information you enter.
 Read the instructions carefully. Where bullet points are part of the instructions, be sure to cover those points at minimum a little bit extra will be fine too.
- If you need a mentor (any 99s member can help you!), contact Jane Link to help you find one.
- The 99s Recommendation and Certification pages (Part VII and VIII) are completed by the Chapter scholarship chairman, Jane Link, after the application is submitted.
- The Colorado Chapter is in the South Central Section.
- Necessary documents may be captured on a phone or scanner, but make sure they are complete, clean, readable and straight as possible.
- Email your application to the Chapter AEMFS chairman, Jane Link no later than 1 April.

Announcing CPA's 2025 Scholarship Program



Soar to New Heights with the 2025 CPA Pilot Training Scholarship Program!

The Colorado Pilots Association (CPA) is proud to announce the opening of applications for our **2025 Pilot Training Scholarship Program**. This year, we're awarding **four scholarships** to deserving Coloradans with a passion for

aviation.

Why Apply?

Earn your Private Pilot's License: Two scholarships, up to \$5,000 each, will be awarded to students aged 16-22 selected through a competitive application process.

How to Apply:

Applications are now open through **March 31**, **2025**. Each applicant will need to submit an Essay and a Letter of Recommendation from their Certified Flight Instructor (CFI).

Apply:

CPA Scholarships: CPA Scholarships

You will need to be logged into your CPA Account prior to selecting the CPA Scholarship link" or can you just add the statement

Wings Over the Rockies Scholarship: WOTR Scholarships

Stipulations:

- Eligibility: Applicants must be Colorado residents.
- Flight Training Location: Training must be completed at a Colorado flight school.
- **Partial Funding:** The scholarship may not fully cover the cost of training. Awardees are responsible for any remaining balance.

Selection Process:

- Application Review: Initial evaluation of the online application form, essay, and CFI letter of recommendation.
- 2. **Academic Achievement:** Preference may be given to applicants who have completed ground school and passed the Aeronautical Knowledge Exam.

Interview: Selected applicants will be interviewed, either in person at Rocky Mountain Metropolitan or Centennial Airport, or virtually.

Key Dates:

- January 1: CPA Application period opens.
- March 31: CPA Application period closes.
- April 15-30: CPA Interviews conducted.
- May 15: CPA Awardees announced.

May 31: CPA Funds released to awardee's flight school.



Chapter Leadership Elections

Every two years, our Colorado Chapter of the Ninety-Nines elects a new board of directors. Nominations are due in April, elections happen at the May meeting, and leaders begin their two-year term in June. Here is a snapshot of the leadership roles with voting privileges that keep our chapter active:

Chairman - Organizes and oversees all Chapter activities. Presides over meetings and serves on each working committee.

Vice-Chairman - Assists the Chairman and performs the duties of the Chairman in her absence. Also assists each of the Committee Chairmen.

Secretary - Records the minutes of each business meeting.

Treasurer - Responsible for all the organization's financial accounts.

Directors - Recruit candidates for officer positions (Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and two Directors), and coordinate the summer picnic and holiday party.

And then there are the various Committee Chairs, who are vitally important to our Chapter's education and outreach efforts:

Airmarking Chairman - Coordinates with an airport manager to paint the 99s compass rose or the name of the airport on the ramp or a taxiway.

Archivist - Maintains Chapter history items and scrapbooks.

Flying Activities Chairman - Coordinates the Chapter's annual fly out event.

Membership Chairman - Responsible for promoting Chapter membership through recruiting and retaining members.

News Reporter - writes up Chapter activities to include in other 99s publications.

Newsletter Editor – Produces and distributes the Crosswind Chatter, our monthly newsletter.

Poker Run Chairman - Coordinates the annual Poker Run event.

Program Chairman - Organizes speakers and activities for the monthly meeting of the members.

Scholarship Chairman - Coordinates the 99s International scholarship programs (Amelia Earhart and Fly Now Awards) and assists applicants.

Chapter Scholarship Chairman - Coordinates the Chapter scholarship programs and assists applicants.

Website & Social Media Chairman - Manages and coordinates the Chapter's public presence on the internet. She may also serve as the Webmaster.

Youth Outreach Chairman - Coordinates the Girl Scout and other programs designed to introduce youth to aviation.

That's a LOT of talent that goes in to running our monthly and annual activities! Not every position is up for election each cycle, but we always welcome new energy, so please let us know where you'd like to help out.
